

We have had a lovely time in the sun this week with most of the children choosing to be outside during Independent Learning Time. In English we started a new story 'Jack and the Jelly Bean Stalk'. In Maths we have been comparing height and sequencing the days of the week. In Phonics we have been blending longer words with double letters in.

In science, we have also been thinking about the outdoors and have planted sunflower seeds which we will nurture and observe over the coming weeks. It was fantastic to see all of the brilliant costumes and we so enjoyed the carousel of activities in KS1 related to the story 'Room on the Broom'.

#### Year 3 Dragonflies & Bumblebees



In English, we began our independent writing and wrote in role as George discussing our nasty grandma! Phew what a busy week!










