For health and safety reasons, children are not permitted to wear earrings for P.E, Games or Dance lessons.

Your child's timetable will identify when these lessons take place so that stud earrings can be removed.

Members of staff are not permitted to remove earrings.

If your child wears stud earrings into school they should be able to remove them.

If this is not possible then parents/carers are requested to tape over earrings before school.

Children will not be permitted to go to Forest School sessions without the appropriate clothing and footwear.

It is important that clothing worn for Forest School will protect children from the extremes of heat and cold, and keep them covered to reduce likelihood of cuts and scrapes.

Further Uniform Guidance

General

- Items which are not on the specified Items list may be obtained from any retailer.
- They must be plain and have no visible logos or trim.
- All school uniform and sports kit **MUST** be named. Children can become upset as a result of lost clothing, please help us by naming everything.
- Clothing must be clean, neat, tidy and be worn modestly.
- Transfer tattoos are not permitted on hands, wrists, arms, or any other part of the body visible during school.
- Pupils are not required to provide a pencil case, stationery or equipment, unless specific items are requested by the class teacher.
- All pupils must follow the reasonable requests of staff with regard to appearance.
- If a parent/carer has difficulties for any reason with fulfilling the uniform requirements, they are asked to speak confidentially to the Headteacher to discuss the issues they are facing.
- Parents/carers should be assured that we will do all we can to help.

Uniform

- Ties must always be worn properly with top buttons fastened.
- Shirts and blouses must be tucked in at the waist.
- Clothing must be clean, neat, tidy and be worn modestly.
- Make up and nail varnish is not to be worn to school.
- Coats must be plain (and not patterned), warm and waterproof and should, where possible, be navy blue, black or dark coloured.
- 'Dryrobe' style coats are not permitted.
- Shoes must be black polished shoes (not trainers) with no open toe, heel or platform.

Hair

- Children's hair must be a natural colour and should be worn in an appropriate style that doesn't interfere with any type of school activity.
- Mohawk hair styles are not permitted.
- Lines or patterns shaved into hair are not permitted.
- Hair shoulder length or longer should be tied back with plain (and not patterned) blue, black or dark coloured hair accessories so that it is off the face.
- If you are considering a particular hairstyle for your child and you are unsure whether it will be appropriate for school then we would urge you to speak with a member of staff first, especially if it is likely to be costly.

Jewellery

- Children may wear 1 plain pair of stud earrings only.
- Hooped earrings are not permitted to be worn.
- No other jewellery may be worn unless it is worn for religious or medical purposes.
- Children may wear a wristwatch. SMART watches are not permitted.
- Children are required to remove any items of jewellery during PE, Dance or Games lessons to prevent them from causing injury. *Please note: members of staff are not permitted to remove earrings.*

Hot weather accessories

- We advise that during summer months children have a hat (as described on Page 3) that stays in school all of the time. When it is especially hot and sunny children will not be allowed to play outside without one.
- Sunglasses are only permitted where permission has been given by the child's class teacher for reasons such as chronic allergies or other medical reasons.
- Handheld fans are permitted but they can only be used in your classroom and must use it sensibly. Handheld fans may not be taken to the dining room or outside for break, lunch or PE. Handheld fans must not be of the variety that sprays water or mist.

If children arrive at school with the incorrect uniform then we will either ask you to bring in the correct item of uniform so that a simple swap can be facilitated or we will provide children with the correct item of uniform from a central supply of spares.

If children arrive at school with nail varnish or make up then in the first instance we will ask them to wash it off. If this is not possible then we will ask that it is washed off for the start of the following school day.

If children arrive at school with an inappropriate hairstyle then we will make contact with you to arrange practical steps to have the hairstyle made 'appropriate for school'.
